

Maths & Numeracy

In **Maths**, the pupils will extend their understanding of the language of time and read both digital and analogue clock times. In **Numeracy**, pupils will develop their subtraction skills and use their knowledge of addition to solve a range of number and word problems; 0-10, 0-20+. Some pupils will investigate the link between repeated addition and multiplication. All pupils will also explore fractions of shapes and amounts as well as how to share groups of items equally.

**Literacy & English**

In Phonics this term, P1 pupils will start to learn Phase 3 sounds as well as apply their knowledge of their initial sounds to spell. P2 pupils will develop their spelling skills further as well as their recognition of sight vocabulary. They will also extend their grammar skills to help them up-level their sentence writing.

All pupils will continue on the school Reading Schemes: Big Cat & Oxford Reading Tree. Pupils will also be introduced to a variety of Scottish texts and poetry this term and will be given the opportunity to learn and recite a poem in Scots.

In writing, the pupils will undertake a variety of imaginative stories and informative texts as well as create their own poetry.

All pupils will be encouraged to form both lowercase and uppercase letters correctly with pupils being encouraged to write on the line.

**P.E.**

This term, the pupils will develop their own fitness and aerobic dance routines. They will also learn to safely use the large gym apparatus. Our P.E. days will remain as

Tuesday and **Wednesday** and for pupil safety, please ensure long hair is tied back and no jewellery is worn on those days.

Health & Wellbeing
