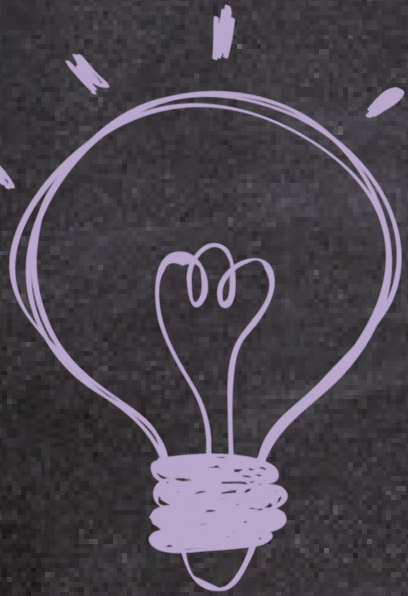

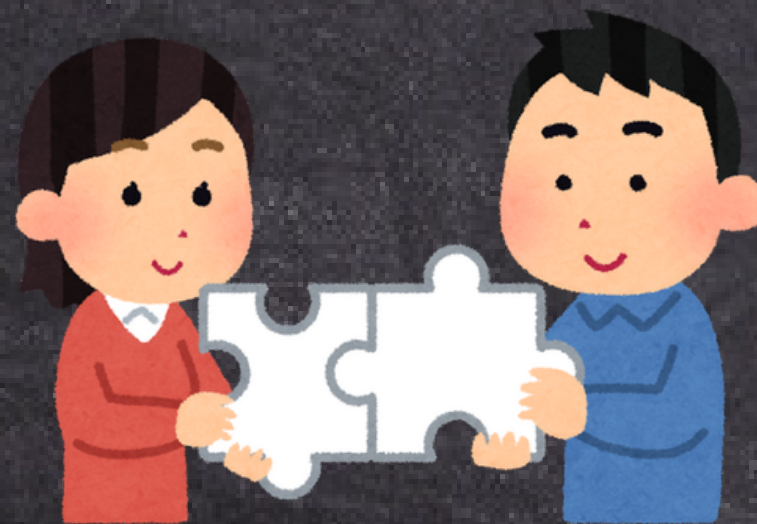

The P1 children and their buddies will spend time together.





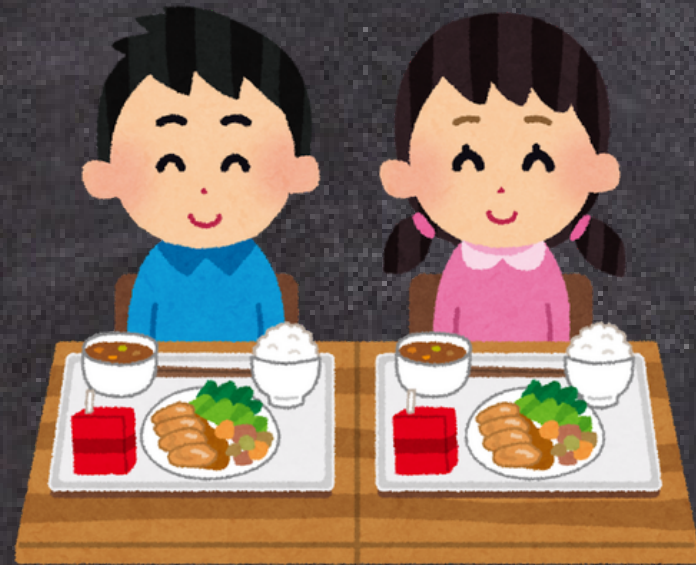

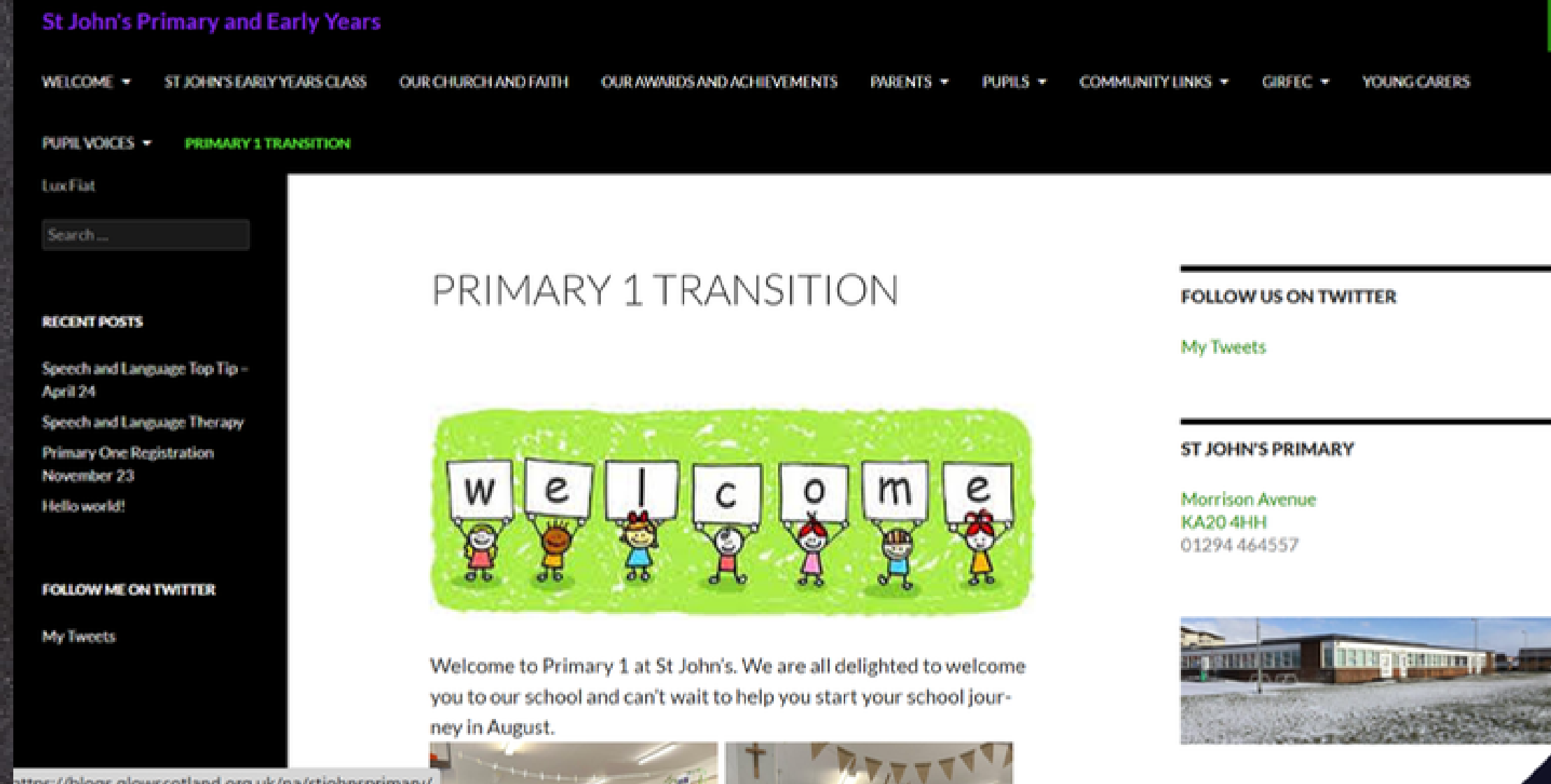

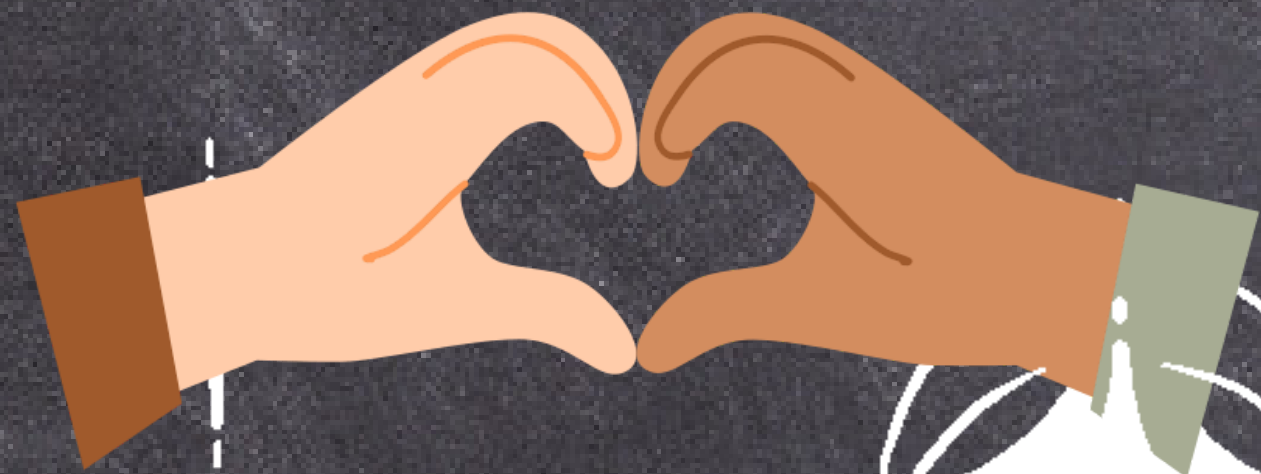

HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD WITH TRANSITION TO SCHOOL?

- READ BOOKS TOGETHER EVERYDAY, REPEAT FAVOURITES OFTEN
 - RECITE NURSERY RHYMES AND EXPLORE RHYMING WORDS
- LOOK FOR NUMBERS IN ENVIRONMENT • SAY NUMBER WORD SEQUENCES FORWARDS AND BACKWARDS
- COUNT ITEMS – STAIRS, PLATES, GRAPES, PEOPLE, SOCKS, CARS, TREES, EVERYTHING!
- PLAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY – BOARD GAMES, JIGSAWS, SPORTS, RUNNING, CHASING, BALL GAMES, ETC. LET YOUR CHILD LOSE!

- ENCOURAGE DAILY SCRIBBLING, DRAWING AND PRETEND WRITING
 - ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO TALK ABOUT THEIR EMOTIONS AND FEELINGS AND REASSURE THEM THAT THEY CAN COPE WITH ALL THE CHANGES AND FEEL SUCCESSFUL
- TALK POSITIVELY ABOUT SCHOOL
- GIVE LOTS OF PRAISE FOR EFFORT RATHER THAN INTELLIGENCE
 - FOCUS ON GOOD BEHAVIOUR
 - REGULAR ROUTINES BUILD INDEPENDENCE – EAT MEALS TOGETHER, ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO DRESS AND UNDRESS THEMSELVES
 - LEAVE ENOUGH TIME TO GET READY – FEELING RUSHED CAN CAUSE UPSET AND MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS HAVING ENOUGH SLEEP (11 TO 12 HOURS)
