## Literacy

#### Reading

This term the class novel is Roald Dahl's 'Matilda'. Pupils will engage with linked activities (including drama) to support their literacy development, They will also continue to be encouraged to read for enjoyment with their own personal choice of book.

## Writing

The class is in the process of transitioning to Talk for Writing (T4W). The writing framework will develop the children's creativity through drama, oral rehearsal and literacy games with the aim of engaging them more in writing. It will enable them to read and write more independently for a variety of purposes.

### Talking and Listening

Pupils will develop their listening and talking skills by presenting information to the class on aspects of their topic work. They will also be encouraged to provide constructive feedback to their peers. T4W will also develop their skills.



# Modern Languages

The class will continue to develop their Spanish vocabulary with Miss Burke. They will be focusing on the Spanish vocabulary for different foods, aspects of Hallowe'en and Dia de los Muertos (Day of the Dead).
