PE: Tuesday and Friday

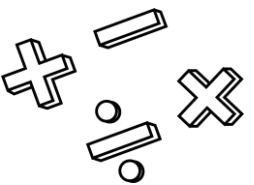
Our PE focus this term is Scottish dancing and racquet skills.
