Term 1: Primary 6

All homework will be given home on a Monday and can be completed on any day/time that is convenient for you, before it is due on a Friday. If possible, it would be helpful if you could try to read with your child as often as you can.

## Numeracy and Maths

This term P6 will be working on place value. They will be investigating how whole numbers are constructed and will be able to use their knowledge to explain the link between a digit, its place and its value.

P6 will learn about 2D shapes and 3D objects. They will be able to identify, name and describe the properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects using appropriate vocabulary.



#### Literacy

P6 will be learning about narrative writing this term. They will be learning how to plan and structure a narrative text and how to include the features in their own writing.

This term P6 will be reading 'Cosmic' by Frank Cottrell-Boyce. They will be learning to identify the main ideas in the text with appropriate detail. They will also be exploring the techniques used to influence the reader, for example, word choice, emotive language, rhetorical questions and repetition.

#### Across the Curriculum



This term our topic in P6 will be Space. P6 will be observing and researching features of our solar system. Primary 6 will explore the topic through a range of activities linked to Literacy, Expressive Arts, Science, Social Studies and Technologies. They will use simple models to communicate their understanding of size, scale, time and relative motion within the Solar System, including how solar and lunar eclipses occur. In Food Technology, P6 will be developing their creativity and confidence when preparing and cooking food. P6 will also be developing their design and engineering skills through a variety of construction challenges.



### RE/Health and Wellbeing

In RE, P6 will begin their journey with the Pope Francis Faith Award. This initiative will help them to grow in faith, compassion and community service. In HWB, P6 will be developing their tennis skills. They will also be developing their ability to express their feelings.



This term, P6 will continue to learn more about their rights. They will be learning more about articles 12, 28, 19 and 31 which emphasize the importance of respect, education, safety and the right to play.
