Numeracy

and Maths

This term P6 will be developing their knowledge of place value. They will be investigating how whole numbers are constructed and will be able to use their knowledge to explain the link between a digit, its place and its value. P6 will learn about 2D shapes and 3D objects. They will be able to identify, name and describe the properties of shape with reference to tessellation, symmetry, faces, edges, sides and anales.



Literacy

P6 will be focusing on narrative writing this term. They will be learning how to plan and structure a narrative text and how to include the features in their own writing.

P6 will be reading 'Wonder' by R.J. Palacio. They will be learning to identify the main ideas in the text with appropriate detail. They will also be exploring the techniques used to influence the reader, for example, word choice, emotive language, rhetorical questions and repetition.

Across the Curriculum



This term P6 will be going back in time to explore 'The Victorians'. They will learn about famous Victorians, schools, workhouses, and how the Industrial Revolution changed towns and cities. Pupils will look at the difference between their lives and those of Victorian children. The topic will also explore inventions from the period and pupils will be developing their own design and engineering skills through a variety of construction challenges. In Science, the class will be investigating renewable and non-renewable sources of energy and exploring ways in which to save energy.

RE/Health and Wellbeing

In HWB P6 will be developing Tennis skills and participating in a variety of Athletics. The class will be developing their ability to express feelings. In RE, P6 will begin their journey with the Pope Francis Faith Award. This initiative will help them to grow in faith, compassion and community service.



This term we will develop our understanding of the different articles contained in the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, We will put them into practice when creating our class charter to ensure our classroom is a happy and safe place to learn.
