Term 2 : Primary 6



Reminders

P.E. is on a Wednesday and Thursday. Homework is set on a Monday and can be completed on any day/time that is convenient, before it is due on a Friday.



Numeracy and Maths

This term P6 will be learning how to use addition, subtraction, multiplication and division when solving problems. They will be learning a variety of mental strategies and written skills to support them when solving number problems.

P6 will be learning to identify and classify angles. They will be able to accurately measure and draw a variety of angles. They will develop their awareness of rotational symmetry in shapes with up to 4 lines of symmetry.



Literacy

P6 will be focusing on procedural writing this term. They will be learning how to plan and structure a procedural text and how to include the features in their own writing.

During reading, children will develop their ability to skim and scan texts to extract information.

They will also gain experience of predicting outcomes using evidence from the text.

In listening and talking, P6 will be developing their ability to share information as well as share and justify their opinions with others.

Across the Curriculum



This term P6 will be starting their 'Self Directed Learning' (SDL) projects. They will be deciding on a theme of their topics, and they will begin to plan out and undertake their own independent learning.

P6 will be learning about and developing their Meta Skills this term with a focus on communication, collaboration, problem solving and developing focus.

In Science, the class will be exploring magnetic and electrostatic forces. They will also be learning about gravitational forces.



RE/Health and Wellbeing

In RE, P6 will continue their journey with the Pope Francis Faith Award. This initiative will help them to grow in faith, compassion and community service. In HWB, P6 will be developing their rugby and golf skills as well as their dancing skills. They will be learning skills and strategies to support them in challenging times.



Rights Respecting Schools

Through engaging with the Connected and Compassionate Classroom resource, P6 will be exploring their rights. They will be learning about the differences between needs, wants and rights.
