Term 3 : Primary 2



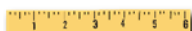
We start a new year and new term full of joy and enthusiasm!

Numeracy and Maths

We are focusing on addition and subtraction this term, using a variety of strategies. The children really enjoy games and group activities which are helping to support and consolidate their learning.

The children are making really good progress in their jotter work with presentation and calculations.



Literacy

Weekly spelling words, practising specific sound patterns continue in class and as homework.

We have completed our first 'big' spelling test of the year, and continue to enjoy literacy games to develop our spelling and reading skills.

We practise sentence-writing daily, always with a personal target to continually improve.

Our writing focus is report writing, and we have started to explore the purpose of different types of texts, discussing fact, fiction and opinion.
