### Numeracy

#### and Maths

This term P6 will be exploring the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. They will investigate the everyday contexts in which simple fractions, percentages and decimal fractions are used and how to solve related problems.

P6 will also be learning how to discuss, describe and classify angles using appropriate mathematical vocabulary.



### Literacy

P6 will be focusing on writing information reports this term. They will be learning how to plan and structure an information report and how to include the features in their own writing. They will develop their note-taking skills to select appropriate information that will be included in their reports.

P6 will learn how to formulate different types of questions about a text with increasing complexity.

In talking and listening, P6 will learn how to create their own text for others to listen to or watch.



### Across the Curriculum

This term P6 will be starting a new 'Self Directed Learning' (SDL) project. They will begin to plan out and undertake their own independent learning on a topic of their choice. P6 will continue to develop their Meta Skills throughout this term with a focus on communication, problem solving, planning, accountability and developing focus. They will have the opportunity to develop their skills in art, technology, science, drama, music and engineering when undertaking their SDL projects.



### RE/Health and Wellbeing

In HWB P6 will be developing their rugby, gymnastics and badminton skills. They will be also be learning to recognise strengths within themselves and how they can be supported to overcome challenges. In RE, they will continue their journey with the Pope Francis Faith Award.



### Rights Respecting Schools

This term we will continue to develop our understanding of the different articles contained in the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. We will be exploring Article 12 - Children have the right to be heard and Article 28 - Children have the right to learn.
