A window into your child's learning

We are excited to be using Seesaw across our school to help families see, celebrate and support learning.

Seesaw is a secure digital learning platform that allows children to share examples of their learning with their teacher and, where appropriate, with their parents and carers.

We will use Seesaw to give you a window into the learning taking place in school. You will see not just what your child has been learning, but sometimes how they have learned it, what they think about their learning and what they can do next.

1 Download the Seesaw app

Download the Seesaw app to your smartphone or tablet. You can also access Seesaw using a web browser on a computer.

2 Use your school invitation

We will provide you with a QR code, invitation link or email invitation. Follow the instructions to create or sign in to your Family Account.

3 Connect to your child's class

Once your account is activated, you will be able to view learning that the teacher has made available to families.

Tip:

If you have more than one child using Seesaw, you can usually connect to each child's account within the same family account.



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Student Code or Family Account?

There are two types of access in Seesaw:

Student Code (For your child)

- ✓ Used by your child
- ✓ Provides access to their Seesaw class and activities
- ✓ Given to your child by the teacher
- ✓ Used for pupil access
- ✓ Do not use this to activate your parent account.



Family Account (For parents and carers)

- ✓ Used by parents and carers
- ✓ Provides family access to learning shared by the school
- ✓ Activated using the school's separate family invitation
- ✓ Used to view and engage with your child's learning
- ✓ This is the account parents/carers should use.



Keep your child's Student Code safe and do not share it publicly.



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How often will learning be shared?

Our aim is to share meaningful learning rather than large quantities of work.

As a general guide, children will have opportunities to share learning across:

- Literacy
- Numeracy/Mathematics
- another area of the curriculum.

There may be approximately 3 meaningful Seesaw posts during a typical week, although this will vary depending on the class, age of the children and learning taking place.

You will not necessarily see something every day. We do not expect every piece of work to be uploaded. Quality and purpose are more important than quantity.

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How can I support my child?

You do not need to be a teacher or provide additional lessons at home. The most valuable thing you can do is show interest in your child's learning.

Try asking:

What were you learning about?

How did you do that?

Can you teach me how to do it?

What would you like to improve?



A short conversation about something your child has shared can be a powerful way of supporting learning.

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A few important things to remember



- ✓ Use Seesaw respectfully and appropriately.
- ✓ Learning shared on Seesaw may include personal information about your child.
- ✓ Seesaw is not about producing more work, but about sharing meaningful learning.
- ✓ Quality and purpose are more important than quantity — you will not necessarily see something every day.
