We have a number of children with low immunity for whom infections can be serious and therefore we must know immediately if they are being exposed to any infectious conditions. We also have a few pupils with serious nut allergies. Please do not send nut based products for snacks/lunch. Your co-operation is very much appreciated.

Teaching staff will continue to use Seesaw as a means of communication. We will issue further information for you detailing how and when we will use this soon.
