#### LITERACY

Reading - Through a whole class study of *The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas*, children will explore World War II themes and strengthen key reading skills. These include **inference**, **empathy**, **character analysis** and **themes**. The story will be used as a springboard to make meaningful links between fiction and real historical events.

Writing – Children will create texts that use persuasive language to influence, inform and engage the reader.

Listening and Talking - The children have been developing their talking and listening skills by preparing and delivering our House Captain speeches - which were very impressive. Pupils are practising active listening and offering constructive feedback to their peers.

### NUMERACY AND MATHS

Number: Children will be deepening their understanding of place value, estimating and rounding. We will explore multiples, factors and prime numbers and we will continue to practise and apply our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Maths The children will be developing their knowledge of 2D and 3D shape as well as calculating perimeter and area of shapes.

Children will develop their metal maths and problem-solving skills each week. Regular times table practise at home is encouraged to support quick recall and overall success in many areas of numeracy.

#### HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Health: Linked to our class novel, *The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas*, children will explore powerful themes of friendship, innocence and prejudice, building empathy and understanding. Children will also work with Hollie (Area Inclusion Worker) to explore healthy relationships through activities/discussions that support personal growth, building confidence and emotional resilience to ease the transition to secondary.

**P.E:** Our gym day is **Thursday**. Children must bring a full kit, including, a t-shirt, appropriate footwear, shorts/sports leggings or joggers.

## IDL (INTERDISCIPLINARY LEARNING)

WWII: Children will explore the key events, significant figures and experiences of World War II. They will learn about the impact of the war on communities, developing both their historical knowledge and understanding of different perspectives.

Enterprise: Towards the end of this term, we will begin preparing for our Enterprise topic, where the children will create and run their own business, gaining hands-on experience and practical skills to support their future in the world of work.
