LITERACY

Reading - Pupils will follow the PM reading programme to build fluency, improve comprehension, and develop retelling skills. They will read a variety of genres and begin summarising and paraphrasing key information from texts. Pupils will participate in a novel study of their own choosing.

Writing - Pupils will recognise and use the key features of information-based writing, including reports and explanation texts. They will learn how to use the relevant technical language and grammatical features of this text type.

Listening and Talking - Through interdisciplinary learning (IDL) and regular class discussions, pupils will strengthen their Oracy skills—learning to communicate clearly, listen actively, and engage confidently in discussions, presentations and group work.

NUMERACY AND MATHS

Numeracy – Mental agility and times tables will be a large part of our learning this term. These skills are essential in enabling our children to progress confidently in number. Pupils will broaden their understanding of place value, rounding and their ability to calculate using the four number operations.

Maths - The focus will be on expanding pupil knowledge about 2D and 3D shapes. They will explore properties, angles, degrees and symmetry.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Science - Pupils will investigate how force can be created and used to power objects of different sizes and shapes. They use their problem solving skills to adapt and improve the performance of their models.

R.M.E - In relation to the new School Values, the children will participate in lessons and discussions around the global concept of The Golden Rule and the positive impact of kindness.
