LITERACY

Class Novel – Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.

<u>SPELLING</u> - Active Literacy spelling resources will be used to enable children to spell commonly used words.

WRITING - Complex Narratives.

<u>READING</u> - PM fiction and non-fiction books will be used to develop literacy skills, with follow-up work to reinforce knowledge and comprehension skills. <u>GRAMMAR & PUNCTUATION</u> – Nouns and Verbs.

At home: Encourage your child to read a variety of genres. Listen to an audio book together and ask questions to support their understanding. Visit the local library.

NUMERACY AND MATHS

This term we will be learning about:

- Place value numbers up to 100 000. Estimation and rounding.
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of three, four and five digit numbers.
- 3D shape, 2D shape and symmetry.
- Multiples, factors and primes.
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

We will be learning about healthy eating and healthy relationships.

P.E. will be on a Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a P.E. kit of shorts/joggers, a t-shirt and separate trainers/gym shoes that they can change into.
