# **Attendance**

Did you know that 90% attendance is not as good as it sounds? If a child has 90% attendance by the end of \$3, they will have effectively missed a whole year of school.

Every day a child misses school can take roughly a week to catch up. If gaps in learning aren't fully addressed, this can start to affect both attainment and self-esteem.

We know that maintaining good attendance can be challenging at times, and we really appreciate your ongoing support in helping your child attend school regularly and make the most of their learning opportunities.

# Writing at Woodlands!



As part of our school improvement plan, all classes are focusing on developing and strengthening writing skills across the curriculum. Children are exploring how different text types are structured and learning about the language features that make each one effective. They are also building confidence in how to plan, write, and edit a range of texts, taking pride in their progress and creativity.

To further support this important work, we are providing additional staffing during pupils' writing slots. This allows for more targeted support, smaller group work, and personalised feedback, helping every child to develop their writing skills at their own pace.

At home, you can help by reading a variety of texts together and chatting about what your child is writing in class — even a short conversation can make a big difference.

Together, we can help our children become confident, creative writers who take pride in their work.
