LITERACY

Primary 1 will be learning about ...

- Digraphs (sh, th, ch, ng, wh, ph, ee, oo, ck, ai, oy, oa)
- Read & spell three/four letter words
- Letter formation
- Vowels (long & short)
- Writing descriptive sentences
- Read sight vocabulary (Magenta, Red and beyond)
- Speech bubbles & speech marks
- Alliteration

NUMERACY AND MATHS

Primary 1 will be learning about ...

- Counting forwards and backwards to 20 and beyond
- Number before, after and in-between
- Count in 2s, 5s & 10s
- Time (seasons, o'clock & half past)
- Ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd and 3rd)
- Doubles/near doubles to 10
- Fractions (equal parts, sharing & grouping)
- Position & Movement (forwards, backwards, left and right)
