Dear Parent / Carer,

Prior to staff returning to Lawmuir our Facilities Support Services Team have been carrying out a deep clean of the building in preparation for us all returning to a 'new normal'. Risk assessments for staff returning have been completed and I'm delighted to tell you that our staff have returned to school to prepare and plan for the return of our pupils in August. Risk assessments for pupils returning will be completed for August.

We are currently working to develop the new operating model for partial delivery/blended learning which will take account of staff capacity and the building capacity to enable us to ensure the safety of all of our pupils. Different schools will have different procedures to fit the needs of the school. The decisions taken for Lawmuir will enable us to make a smooth transition towards a new normal. School procedures will be different when children return. We have three coloured zones for entering the campus,. You will be issued with information which details which zone your child should use to enter/exit the campus. Start and finish times will be staggered as will break and lunchtimes. Please note that children will not be allowed to leave the campus during the school day, this includes during lunchtime. All children will be required to stay in school for lunch. They can either bring a packed lunch or order a school dinner. There is no crossing patrol during lunchtime.

During our Recovery phase, pupils will attend school for two days, either Monday & Tuesday or Thursday & Friday. These will be communicated to you individually. We hope the app will aid communication




To download the app go to the Apple or Google store to download the Scot Ed app onto your device. Once you have downloaded the app search for the school name - Lawmuir Primary.
