All classes will be using the context of Christmas to develop learning in December. This context will integrate a range of curricular areas and develop skills in real life, engaging activities.

Indoor PE from **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> November** will focus on practices for the party so children will only need their indoor shoes. Classes will have their normal outdoor PE time and will still need a change of clothes for outdoors.

We will have a children's raffle, with a large range of prizes, for all of December. This raffle is very much for children!! Tickets will be **25p each** and it will be drawn at our Christmas service.
