NURSERY SESSION TIMES

Just a reminder of the nursery session times each day. Remember your child is entitled to 3 hours and 10 minutes nursery education for five sessions each week.

MORNING SESSION 8.40am - 11.50am

AFTERNOON SESSION 1pm - 4.10pm.

All children should be collected by the end of their session time. Our nursery doors will only be open at the times stated above due to security reasons. Please make sure you inform us of who is collecting your child at the end of the session.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS

Please make every effort to keep us informed of your current contact numbers in case we need to get in touch with you during the nursery session. Please remember to also keep us up to date with those family members or friends you have listed as emergency contacts should you not be available.

JACKETS, SHOES ETC

Can you please put your child's name on all shoes, jumpers and jackets as some children have identical shoes, jackets etc. and we like to make sure they have their own items of clothing on? Please also ensure that your child has a full change of clothes in his/her bag in the event they need to get changed.

£1.50 PER WEEK TOY FUND

As a nursery we ask you to contribute £1.50 a week to our toy fund. This enables us to buy resources to promote an active curriculum and enhance learning experiences. Every week a child will be in charge of collecting the

money in the money boxes. This will encourage familiarity with money and using a chart.

SNACK

We encourage the children to eat a healthy snack every day. In the nursery we have a shopping list of what we need. It would be much appreciated if you could buy any items from the list and put your name up on the board. The list will be located in the foyer area.

FOREST KINDERGARTEN

We are planning our first trip on Wednesday 27th September to a local wooded area where children will be encouraged to play, explore and learn in the natural environment. We have been unable to find a suitable area that is within walking distance so we ask that on the day you bring your child and meet us. We plan to meet at the Snack Bar at the bottom of Castlehill Road at 9.30am and 1.30pm. There is quite a large car park there. We ask that on this day parents stay with their children in order to provide them with the best possible experience. More information about clothing will follow nearer the time.
