HOMEMADE LENTIL SOUP – YUM YUM!



Ingredients: 1 onion, 2 rashers smoked baking, 2 carrots, 3 celery sticks, 2 veg stock cubes, 2 ham stock cubes, 300g red splint lentils, 3 ltr water, half a tsp parsley, a pot

Method:

Step 1: Firstly you will have to chopped up all the onion, carrots and celery sticks into little cubes

Step 2: Second you will put the veg into the pot and then put in the water

Step 3: Thirdly once the water has heated up put in the stock cubes

Step 4: Once the stock cubes are dissolved then put the lentils

Step 5: leave to sit for 40 mins and stir every so often

Step 6: add a pinch of salt and pepper and serve.

HOMEMADE SAUSAGE ROLLS



Ingredients: 100g puff pastry (frozen)

4 skinless sausage

Egg to glaze

Method:

Step 1: set the oven to 220C or gas mark 7

Step 2: lightly flour the table

Step 3: roll out the defrosted pastry into a thin strip

Step 4: place sausages along the strip of pastry

Step 5: wet the long edge of pastry

Step 6: fold the pastry over the sausage to cover and

press and seal the edges

Step 7: cut into 8 pieces, snip the top of the pastry

using scissors place on a baking tray

Step 8: brush top only with beaten egg

Step 9: bake for 20-25 minutes until golden brown

on top and bottom

Step 10: garnish with salad.

SAVOURY RICE



<u>Ingredients</u>: 50g long grain rice, 10ml vegetable oil, 1 small onion, 250mls beef stock, 1 mushroom, ½ red pepper, ¼ green pepper, 15ml frozen peas, 10ml curry paste

Method:

Step 1: Peel and chop onion finely, wash mushrooms and peppers, slice mushrooms and dice the peppers Step 2: Add oil to the pan and heat. Cook onion until soft.

Step 3: Wash rice in sieve. Add to pan and stir, using a metal spoon.

Step 4: Add the beef stock and curry paste. Cook gently until the stock is almost absorbed (about 10 minutes)

Step 5: Add mushrooms and peppers to the pan, cook for 5 minutes.

Step 6: Add frozen peas and cook for further 5 minutes

Step 7: Garnish with parsley and serve.

Coconut Buns



Oven:200 c or 5 gas

Ingredients:

100g s r flour
40g Caster sugar
40g margarine
½ beaten egg
25g coconut
Milk to mix

Method:

Step 1. Preheat oven

Step 2. Sieve flour. Rub in margarine until mixture looks like fine breadcrumbs

Step 3. Stir in sugar and coconut

Step 4. Mix in egg and milk gradually to the mixture to give a stiff consistency

Step 5. Using a dessert spoon, spoon the mixture onto a tray in rough heaps

Step 6. Bake in a hot oven for 15 minuets or until golden brown.

French pupils do not have RME because they believe that no religion should be taught or practiced in school.




Pupils in France do not wear a school uniform!!

Adidas is from Herzogenaurach, Germany. Nike is from Oregon, America. Ellesse is from Italy.





Interesting facts!!!!

Many astronomers believe that Mercury might be the core of what was once a much larger planet -- it appears to be a huge ball of iron covered by a thin layer of rock.

Venus is the brightest planet in our sky and can sometimes be seen with the naked eye if you know where to look.

Earth has more exposed water than land. Three quarters of the Earth is covered by water! The earth has one moon.

Mars is the home of "Olympus Mons", the largest volcano found in the solar system. It stands about 27 kilometers high with a crater 81 kilometers wide.

Jupiter is the largest planet in the solar system, but it spins very quickly on its axis. A day on Jupiter lasts only 9 hours and 55 minutes. I get dizzy just thinking about it!

Saturn is the second biggest planet, but it's also the lightest planet. If there was a bathtub big enough to hold Saturn, it would float in the water!

Uranus' axis is at a 97 degree angle, meaning that it orbits lying on its side! Talk about a lazy planet.

Neptune was discovered in 1846. In 2011 it finally made it's first lap around the sun since we discovered it -- because one Neptune year lasts 165 Earth years!

Pluto's orbit sometimes brings it closer to the Sun than Neptune. It jumped ahead of Neptune on September 5, 1989 and remained there until February, 1999 when it went back to being the farthest.
