



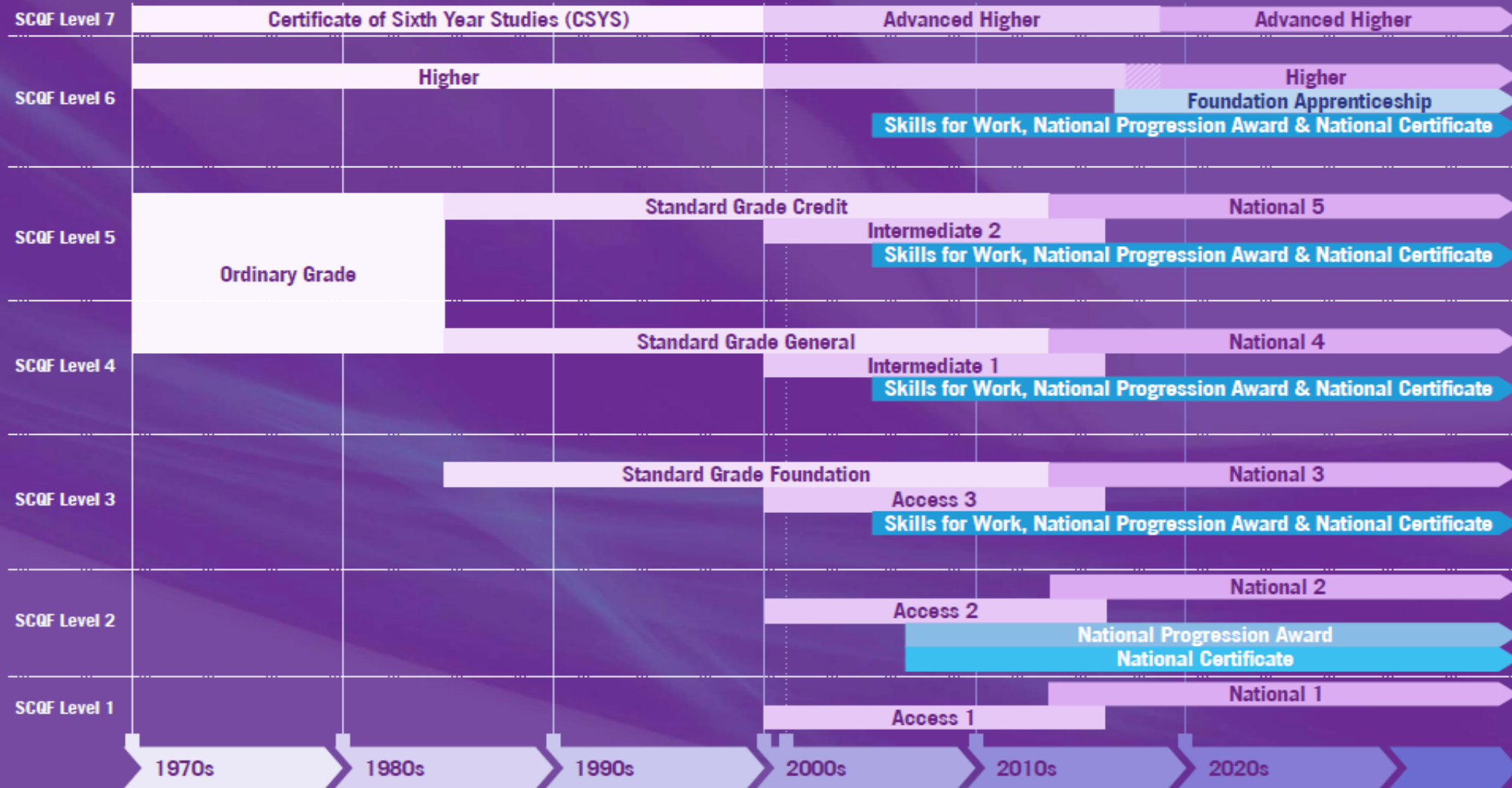

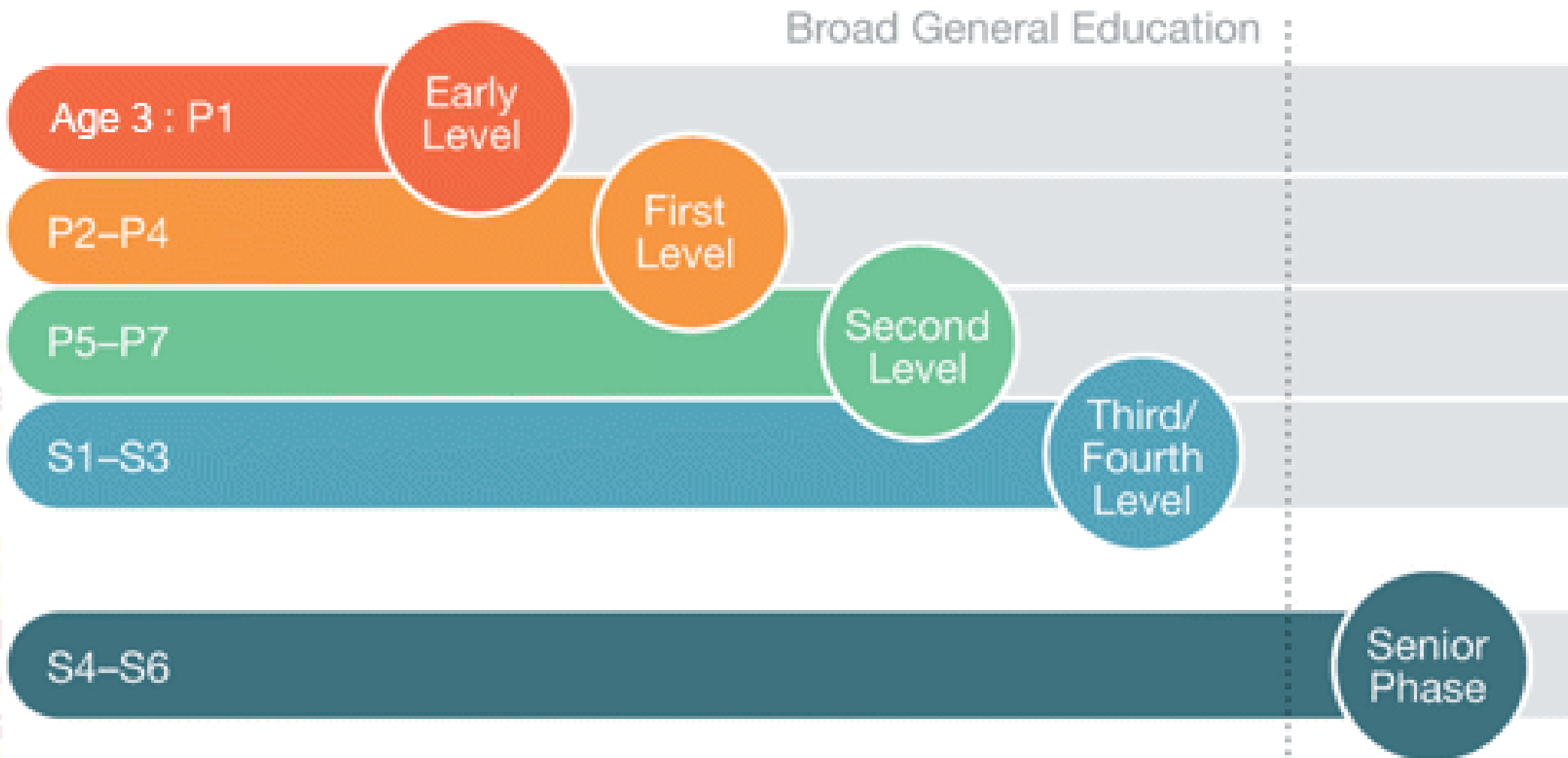
North Lanarkshire Labour Market

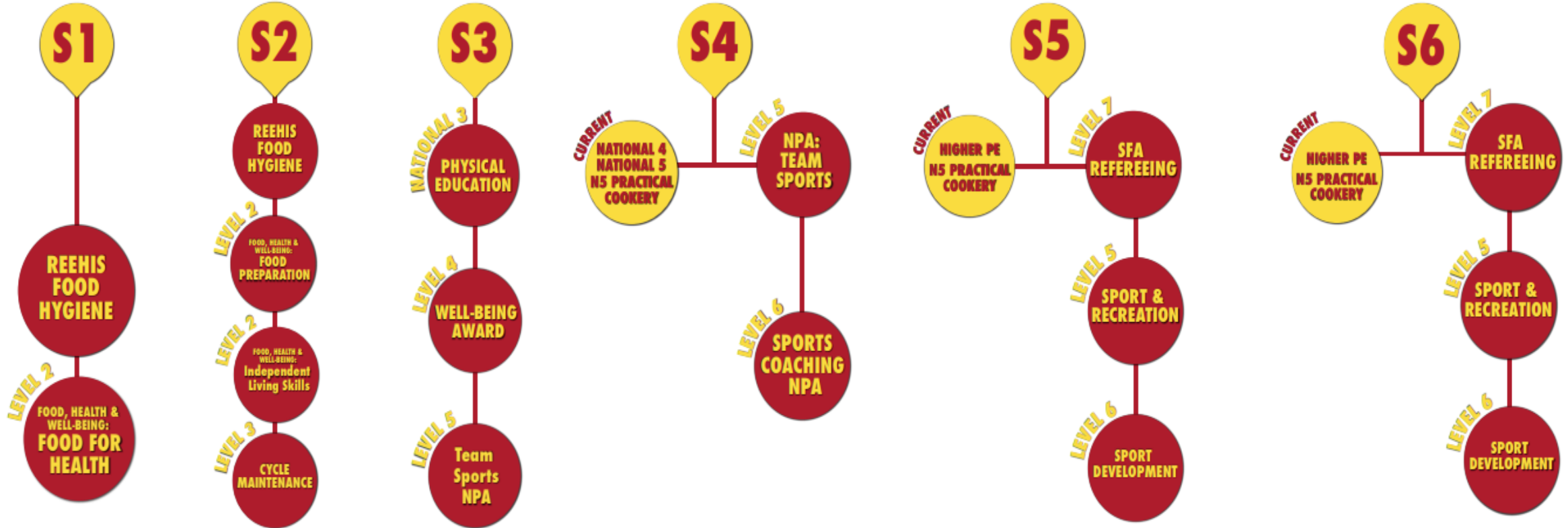

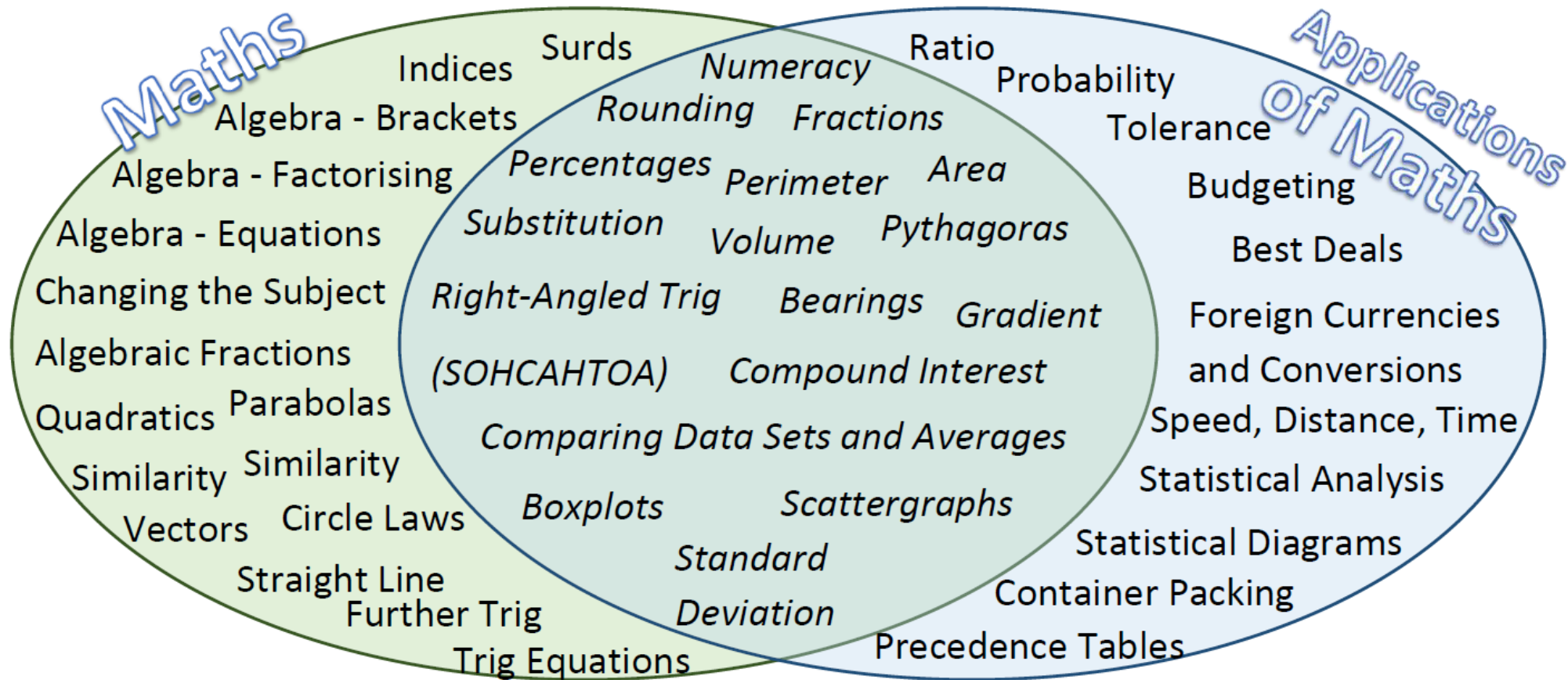
