Through the use of Glow we aim to:

- realise the potential of all young people within North Lanarkshire;
- support Curriculum for Excellence;
- provide all young people with a set of state-of-the-art online tools and services that will support and enhance their learning;
- enable educators to come together in dynamic communities of learning;
- enable parents, carers and the wider community to have greater involvement in children's learning.



Glow is a Scottish Government initiative, a national intranet for learners and educators. Powerful learning tools such as Office 365 (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and OneNote), document stores, discussions forums, web conferencing, blogs and wikis are provided in a safe and secure online environment. All users have access to unlimited cloud storage in OneDrive where they can store learning resources and keep their work in the form of text, images, video and audio files.

Users can access learning spaces created by teachers anytime and anywhere, using almost any device which can connect to the Internet. Through the use of Glow we plan to open up learning giving our young people greater access to learning opportunities within and beyond the school day.
