Some Author and Reading Suggestions mainly for S3 Pupils' Upwards.

 The listed authors are only a few of many, many authors and although the suggestions are for S3 upwards, a few S1/S2 pupils' will want to read them.

- Perhaps double check with your parents/carers before you choose to read them if you are \$1/\$2.
- There are also a few online links where you can review books and also read first chapters of books before you decide to read the whole book. You may have to register on some of these sites before downloading a hard copy of the first chapter.
- There is a link to North Lanarkshire Libraries where you can search their library catalogue and remember, library books are free and you only have to join.
- The public library also has eBooks, eAudiobooks, eReference books and eMagazines. These are also free.

Here are some tips on how to choose a book.

Blurb - Does the description in the blurb draw you in?

Emotion - What sort of mood are you in? Do you want something to make you laugh or something to scare you?

<u>Series</u> - Is this book part of a series? If you have read the first one you might like the rest.

<u>Topic</u> - Is the topic of the book something that interests you?

<u>Cover</u> - There are some clues on the cover but REMEMBER you can't judge the whole book by the cover!

Length - Is the length of the book about right for you?

<u>Author</u> - Have you read anything by this author before? You might like to read more from that author or another author who writes like them. You can research that on review websites.

<u>Recommendations</u> - ASK friends, teachers, librarians and parents and when you go **shopping** look at the book shelves to see what is popular!
