

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


One of the best ways to get experience in your chosen industry is work experience. This will allow you to experience a realistic 'day in the life', and work out what pathway you would like to take in your future.

Many individuals consider a career in banking as uninteresting or out of reach. We appreciate that many people might not consider it as an option up until they experience it for theirselves. So, to help decide if banking is an option for you, we have the HSBC Work Experience scheme. This applies to anyone in the UK aged between 14 - 19 years old and in full time secondary or sixth form education. This work experience runs for 1 week in June, July or August, and could take place in local branches, Commercial and Operational centres or our Head Office in Birmingham.

During your time, you will be shadowing current employees, working on different business projects and even presenting your ideas on real life situations you encounter at the bank. If you do well, it could even lead to a permanent entry level opportunity or onto our apprenticeship programme.

In 2019, **over 97%** of our programme rated their placement as 'Satisfactory' or above, with **over 70%** rating it 'Outstanding'



Foundation Apprenticeships

As a bank, we enable businesses to thrive and economies to prosper, helping people fulfil their hopes and realise their ambitions. This means people are at the heart of everything we do.

We are looking for individuals who share our passion for exceptional customer service. This is why we offer apprenticeships in a range of customer facing roles. This includes opportunities within our local branch network, contact centres and Commercial Business centres.

Our Foundation Apprenticeships give you the opportunity to **earn whilst you learn**, paying over triple the National Minimum Wage. We also fund and support your studies, allowing you to achieve externally recognised professional qualifications whilst also being a full time, permanent employee.

Our success comes from our people, so you can be sure of constant coaching and development throughout your apprenticeship. Our qualification pass rate is **35% higher** than the national average and **over 80%** of our Apprentices are in a position of more responsibility within just 12 months.

Our Foundational Apprenticeships are open to all, not just School and College leavers.

An Alternative to University

Our Degree Apprenticeship provide a real alternative to the University route. Introduced in 2019, this programme consists of a structured 4 year rotational course, giving you working experience across different areas of our Commercial Banking function whilst also allowing you to study for a **BSc (Hons) Degree** in Banking Practice and Management from the London Institute of Banking and Finance.

The Degree Apprenticeship is a full time, permanent position combining your work and studies. Crucially, your degree is **fully funded by HSBC**, meaning **no** tuition fees. This allows you to get a Degree and practical working experience to put you ahead of your peers, all whilst earning a **highly competitive salary**.

Our Degree Apprenticeship programmes are all based in the Midlands, offering a clear and achievable progression pathway to give you a platform to succeed. As testament to our investment in people, this programme is also open to existing staff through an internal portal, allowing you the opportunity to progress.






