

Digital School
Future Friday's Offer

The Digital School will make an offer to young people through Future Fridays. The planned offer will be developed over three phases. Each part of the programme focusing on the development of Digital Skills and knowledge which young people will require in learning, life, and work.

The delivery of the Digital School's offer will be from the Pathfinder Teaching staff initially, enhanced by the SAM Group and supported by Digital Inclusion Lead and Digital School Lead. Links with practitioners within schools will be explored further to enhance the proposed model.

As Part 1 of the programme will be delivered by Pathfinder Teaching staff, time is needed to ensure they have the skills and confidence to deliver this to young people. Parts 2 and 3 will also have Digital Pathfinder teacher involvement, however these elements will also be reliant on planning from wider organisations which is why these come in later.

The proposals listed below are currently in draft and will be confirmed by Jill Woodward, Education and Families Manager with strategic lead for Digital by Wednesday 25th August 2021.

Part 1 – planned start 27th August 2021

Will focus on the core digital skills that will be needed by young people. Looking to have 3 programmes that can be done online, some with support and some individual modules that young people work through.

- Core Microsoft Office 365 skills
- Internet Safety, Cyber Security and Digital Footprint
- Microsoft Digital Future Programme

Part 3 – planned start from 22 October 2021

This final part will focus on giving young people access to accredited modules of digital skills and computing science learning. The Digital School will research and then publish a list of coursed modules young people can undertake.

Delivery of this element is dependent on the UKCRF grant approval.

Part 1 and 2 of the Digital School offers all provide young people with accredited opportunities through the Young STEM Leaders Programme and the Microsoft Digital Future Programme.
