FAQs

Question: Is the programme open to everyone?

Answer: Yes. All young people in S1-6 are able to attend every Friday afternoon.

Question: When do activities begin?

Answer: At 1.15pm

Question: When do activities finish?

Answer: At 3.00pm

Question: Does my child have to attend every week?

Answer: No. Young people can come on the weeks that suit them and their parents.

Question: How will I know what activities my child is taking part in?

Answer: We have provided young people with a list of activities we can currently provide. They are able to choose from this list.

Question: Does my child have to do the same activity each week?

Answer: No. Your child can choose from any of the activities we have on offer each week.

Question: How will I know if my child is attending?

Answer: We will keep accurate lists of all young people attending the various activities each week. If you want to make sure your child is here – contact the school office.

Question: What if my child travels on school transport?

Answer: School transport leaves at 12.35pm on Fridays. If your child is eligible for school transport and is taking part in Future Fridays, please agree with them how you want them to get home. We can provide these young people with their bus fare for the service bus.

Question: Is the canteen open for lunch on Fridays?

Answer: Yes, the canteen is open for lunch as normal on a Friday.

Question: Where will I find information about Future Fridays?

Answer: We will send information in our regular parent / carer updates. We have also set up a Future Fridays Page on the school website and a Microsoft Future Friday Team.
