Who is eligible?

In order to be eligible, you need to be:

- On the autism spectrum, or seeking a diagnosis
- Aged 10 to 15
- Not engaging with education at a school within **Glasgow City Council** or **North Lanarkshire Council**
- Living within a postcode identified as being within the 20% most deprived on the Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation
