Drop off and Collection


Thank you for ensuring you wear a mask at drop off and pick up times while you wait for your child/ren.

OUR SCHOOL IS NUT FREE!

All schools in Scotland are Nut Free schools. This means that items containing nuts are not allowed in school. This does not simply apply to Peanuts!

We have children in school with serious nut allergies. This means that they could become seriously (sometimes life threateningly) ill if they come into contact with nuts.

Please do not send any dangerous items into school—either as snacks or as packed lunches.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS ...

As you may know the council took the decision on 24 February 2020 to incorporate "full cost recovery for school meals". The school meal service is subsidised by the council and due to extreme financial pressures can no longer sustain this level of costs.

When COVID hit in March 2020 the service postponed the increase which should have happened on the 1 April 2020. The price increase will now be applicable from 26 October and the new price of a 2 course primary school meal will be ± 3.00 and the price of a secondary school 2 course meal will be ± 3.05 . A 3% annual inflationary rise will be incorporated thereafter.

The new school meal price still represents value for money and cannot be compared to the previous subsided price. Both the Primary and the Secondary meal price includes a two course lunch. In a primary school the choice is soup and main course plus water or milk or a main course and sweet treat plus water or milk. Also to reassure parents/carers that the school meal service has worked hard to provide a safe working environment and staff are working to COVID 19 protocols.

Your child may be entitled to free school meal and essential clothing grant. You can check your benefits and how your application is processed via the council's website at https://www.northlanarkshire.gov.uk/index.aspx?articleid=5452

ALL Primary 1 to Primary 3 pupils are automatically entitled to receive a free school meal but must be included in your application form.

You can also download the Free School Meals & Clothing Grant application form from the website details above.

If your application for Free School Meals is accepted then the school will be notified immediately.

IT IS WORTH NOTING THAT... During lockdown, families were entitled to a voucher for £20 per child, per week which was texted or emailed if the children were in receipt of a Free School Meal.

IF YOUR FAMILY HAS TO SELF ISOLATE FOR 14 DAYS... Those families who have children in receipt of a Free School Meal will receive a voucher to assist them during that time.



WHAT IS THE PROVISION IF MY FAMILY IS HAVING TO ISOLATE?

North Lanarkshire Council has put in place a comprehensive strategy to support families if they have to self isolate for any period of time. This involves...

- The school informs North Lanarkshire.
- North Lanarkshire writes to Parents/Carers.
- Community Assistance contacts the family to support (e.g., Free School Meals so that vouchers can be sent to families to continue the provision of daily meals, Financial Inclusion Team if support is required, Community Assistance if other special support is required (e.g. special prescription delivery, dog walking, etc.)
- The school writes to families to inform them of what Learning Materials will be on offer and how to access these.
- The school will contact the family by telephone each week of isolation.

Help and support will be available throughout and we encourage you to contact us if you need anything... even something not related to school!
