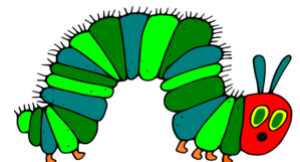

Reminders

Please note the exclusion periods for various illnesses displayed in the cloakroom. With sickness and diarrhoea of any kind, children should be excluded for 48 hours from the last bout. A reminder that the School and Nursery are a nut free zone, so please ensure your child does not bring any related items in with them, as they can have serious consequences for a child with allergies. Thank you.

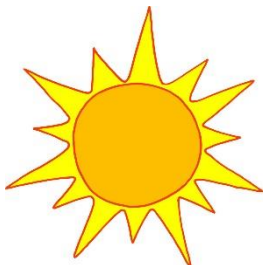
