
Eastfield Primary & Nursery 'Summer Fete' (Saturday 11th June '15)


As highlighted by our Parent Council within their recent news flyer, we are delighted to be holding our annual Summer Fete at

In line with North Lanarkshire Council Policy, Eastfield Primary School and Nursery Class are designated 'No Smoking" areas. School Uniform

As we approach Spring and Summer, we are conscious that parents/carers are beginning to consider the purchase of school uniforms for next session. Following parental feedback, requesting the formal endorsement of a consistent school uniform throughout the school, the school and Parent Council would like to highlight the following guidance.



Eastfield's Primary School's policy is that all our pupils are required to wear the school uniform.

The School Uniform consists of:

- 1. A white school shirt / blouse, and school tie which is visible at all times
- 2. A white school poloshirt complete with the school badge or alternatively a white poloshirt complete with a school tie
- 3. Dark grey 'smart' trousers, skirt or pinafore (leggings, jeans, denim and track suits are not acceptable, under any circumstances)
- 4. Dark grey tights should accompany a skirt or pinafore
- 5. A navy school jumper or cardigan complete with the school badge or a plain navy jumper or cardigan (No hooded tops)
- Sensible plain black shoes.
