Our Learning Achievements

<p>Literacy & Language</p>	<p>We have been consolidating and learning new sounds to help us read, write and spell. We have been reading the Giraffe Pelly and Me by Roald Dahl in class which we enjoyed. We use our reading books in class to find information. Thank you for supporting our homework.</p>
<p>Numeracy & Mathematic</p>	<p>We are practising lots of mental maths. Multiplication tables, addition, number sequences place value and calendar work. We have been using calendars to plan events and learning new vocabulary to describe events e.g. 3 days = 72 hours, fortnight = 2 weeks = 14 days.</p>
<p>Health & Wellbeing</p>	<p>We are learning ball skills and playing games showing good teamwork in P.E. In order to 'Get it Right for Every Child' we are also learning about how to keep and feel safe within our Health topic including internet safety.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p>	<p>We enjoy our music assembly with Mrs MacMillan each week. We have been learning new songs. We are developing our skills in artwork and we have linked art to our class novel and to our preparation for our assembly.</p>
<p>Religious & Moral Education</p>	<p>Within our RME, we are learning about Eid-al-Adha, which is a Muslim celebration on 24th September 2015 this year. It marks the end of Hajj and to Abraham's willingness to sacrifice his son to God. Making a sacrifice and giving to charity is an important part of this celebration.</p>
<p>Social Studies & Science</p>	<p>We have been learning how a lighthouse works and where some lighthouses are situated around Scotland, linking to our Lighthouse Keeper stories. To learn and encourage the children to be Eco friendly we have been growing some cress to eat and sowing some sunflowers. We have also been discussing the damage littering can have on the Earth.</p>
<p>Technologies</p>	<p>We have been learning how to be Eco friendly. Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. We used an old cardboard box to make the sweet shop "The Grubber" from our class novel. We have also been discussing how to make a lighthouse.</p>
<p>Other</p>	<p>We are also learning how to work well in a team and with our partners.</p>
