

In literacy, we are learning to:

- Use our knowledge of phonemes we have covered when writing independently to spell words correctly.
- Continue learning our common words so we can say, read and write them.
- Continue with our reading strategies at home and at school to build our fluency.
- Identify nouns, verbs and adjectives in our reading books.
- Retell events that have occurred in order in my writing.
- Use a variety of connectives to make sentences more detailed.

Interdisciplinary Contexts ("IDL")

Children will be studying the 'Super Human Body' this term and will be learning about:

- *How our bodies keep us alive.
- *The functions of the main organs- heart, brain and lungs.
- *How disease can spread and what we can do to prevent this.
- *The importance of keeping ourselves healthy.

In Health and Wellbeing we are learning:

- The importance of keeping ourselves fit and healthy and different ways to do this.
- How to give and receive feedback when performing.
- How to discuss our feelings.

Wider Curriculum

- In music we will be learning Christmas/Winter songs.
