



Setting Up an Apple ID

To download apps from the Apple App store you will need to have an Apple ID set up. Most people set up their Apple ID's when setting up their iPhone or iPad but if not, one can easily be set up using an existing email address.

Creating an Apple ID:

1. On your Apple device, open the App Store by tapping on the App Store icon.



2. Search for a free app such as SSA, PSA or DNA.



3. Tap **Get** next to the apps icon.
4. A pop-up will appear asking you to sign into an Apple ID. Tap on **Create New Apple ID**.
5. Choose a country of residence that matches your billing address, the tap **Next**.
6. Read the Apple Privacy Policy, then tap **Agree**, if prompted tap **Agree** again.
7. Complete the on-screen form to create your new Apple ID. The email address you provide will become your Apple ID username.
8. When you've entered your security questions, tap **Next** to complete the form.
9. You'll now be asked to enter billing information. This information is for verification and security purposes by Apple. Apps Central apps will never charge you.
10. After you have entered your billing information you will be asked to verify your Apple ID by email. To do this go to the inbox of the email address you have just provided and follow the instructions in the email from Apple.

Once you have verified your email address you are free to start browsing the Apple App Store and downloading apps.
