


# Nursery Newsletter



## Our topic

We are currently covering road safety as part of our topic, being safe in the car park is a good way to demonstrate this to your child.

### Online profiles

We hope you are enjoying looking at all the hard work your children have been doing at nursery on their online profile. You can comment on your child's profile, save it to your computer and also print it out. If you have any difficulty logging on to your child's profile please speak to a member of staff.

### Parent workshops

Mrs Winchester held her Sid and Shanari workshop recently and all parents and children who attended found it interesting and informative. Mrs Gallagher will be holding a Three Read Workshop, aimed at pre-school parents and children on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> December a sign up sheet will be displayed in the cloakroom.

### Reminders

Please could you make sure that your child has a change of clothes in their cream bag in case of an accident or after playing in the water, as we have limited spare clothes. We recommend that you ensure that your child does not have laces on their shoes for nursery and home time, as this can result in your child being upset if they can not put their own shoes on. We would ask that your child does not bring in any toys to nursery as they can be mislaid, children can also become upset if another child plays with them.

Please note the exclusion periods for various illnesses are displayed in the cloakroom. With sickness and diarrhoea of any kind, children must be excluded for 48 hours from the last bout to stop cross infection.

A reminder to parents that our nursery policy folder is on display in the welcome area.

**Please note the £3 weekly for the snack fund helps to pay for resources, snack, treats for the children and special events. The box is located opposite the signing in sheets.**

### Drop off and pick up times

**Can you please inform a member of staff if another person or parent is picking up your child, as we have to ensure that you have given them permission to do so.**

We ask that you please be patient at drop off and pick up times, as staff members are setting up or working with children and may not be available to open the door out with drop off times listed below. Thank you

Occasionally we understand that there may be a need to drop your child out with these times please go to the school reception on these occasions. The nursery has a welcome time at the start of each session, which is an important part of the day for your child to attend. **Late attendance can impact on your child settling in to the daily routine as part of their group.**
