

In literacy, we are learning to:

P2:

- Use a dictionary and sort information into alphabetical order.
- Link sentences using simple conjunctions.
- Plan for writing and follow the format chosen.
- Cont. to develop independence in decoding new and unfamiliar words.

P2/3

- Explain our preference for particular texts and authors.
- Cont. Ask questions to help us understand texts and learn new things.
- Cont. Independently recognise and write a range of common words.

P3:

- Identify the main idea of a chapter.
- Answer inferential questions and explain our reasons by referring back to the text.
