

In Literacy, we are learning to:

- Explore and play with patterns of sounds and language.
- Read and listen to texts, sharing our likes and dislikes.
- Develop our ability to take part in conversation.
- Ask questions to help us understand texts and learn new things.
- Say, make, break, blend, read and write words.
- Recognise and write a range of common words.

In Health & Wellbeing we are learning about:

- Our rights and how to respect the rights of others.
- How to move and control our bodies well through practice and energetic play.
- To think about healthy heating
- How to take turns and share resources.



In Maths, we are learning to:

- Explore numbers and understand that they are used to represent quantities.
- Use numbers to create sequences, describe order and count.
- Understand where numbers are placed on a number line and identify numbers before/after.
- Identify numbers represented in a variety of ways.
- Become aware of our daily routines and link them with specific days of the week.
- To identify 2d shapes and 3D objects.
- Spot continue and create patterns.
- To think about strategies we can use to help us to add and to carry out simple addition problems.

Interdisciplinary Contexts
