

## In literacy, we are learning:

- ❖ Read fluently with good understanding of characters and events.
- ❖ Regularly share the names of authors that we enjoy and experience these authors in our class library.
- ❖ Write with confidence and independence in variety of genres – narrative and information reports this term. Self check and improve our own writing on a regular basis.
- ❖ Use techniques and gain inspiration from real authors to enhance our own writing – descriptive language, similes and more.
- ❖ Work hard to spell common and tricky words correctly on a daily basis by using our knowledge of phonemes and other tools in class.
- ❖ Talk about our learning with increasing confidence and listen respectfully to our peers and the teacher.

## In Health & Wellbeing, we are learning:

- ❖ PE – P5 are developing excellent skills in Judo and building their confidence by participating in this contact sport every Wednesday afternoon.
- ❖ Let's get Physical! – the outdoor environment is used when possible to do our Daily Mile and develop ball skills, team work and coordination.
- ❖ Understanding the importance of safe and hygienic methods while improving our hands on cooking experience.

## In maths, we are learning:

- ❖ Further develop our Place Value knowledge and become confident when working with 4/5 digit numbers.
- ❖ Participate in morning Daily Challenge that reinforces the learning and teaching of all the main concepts... +, -, x, ÷
- ❖ Celebrate achievements by taking part in active games that give pupils the chance to share their abilities and increase their mental agility.
- ❖ Talk about our method of reaching a solution mentally to deepen our own understanding and help our peers think of new ways to learn.
- ❖ Time – we are working on all aspects of analogue time and then moving onto digital displays. We shall be extending our knowledge by trying to calculate time intervals.
- ❖ Multiplication and division – continue to make links between multiplying and dividing knowledge and apply this to challenges set in class.

- ❖ We commenced Term 1 with a Science based topic – Light and Sound. The showcase days provided the opportunity to share our learning and this was a success.
- ❖ Following on from this we are delving into Scottish History by studying the Scottish Wars of Independence.
