Breakfast Club, Drop Off and Collection

Please continue to use the one-way system to ensure efficient drop off and collection. By following this, you will support the safe and speedy arrival and departure of all children. Thank you to everyone for supporting the school and our children with this.

Breakfast Club opens at 8.15am and is accessed via the external door to Gym 2. There is no need to register your child; please use as you require it and remember that, as with school lunches, there is no charge for P1 to P5 children.

Morning Drop Off is from 8.45am. No children should be in the Playground prior to this, as it is unsupervised. P1 to P3 children should use the Infant Gate and P4 to P7 children should use the Senior Gate. Siblings can enter via the same gate.

At Collection at 3pm, P1 to P3 children will exit via the Infant Gate and P4 to P7 children will exit via the Senior Gate. Siblings may exit from the same gate; please ensure that your children and their Class Teachers are aware of such arrangements. Please also ensure that you follow the one-way system to ensure the safe and speedy departure of all children.

Bikes and Scooters

If your child is cycling or scooting to school, please ensure they are wearing a helmet and remind them to park (and lock) their bicycle or scooter in the bike shed in the Primary 4/5 Playground. Bikes and Scooters are left entirely at your own risk and neither NLC nor the school accept liability for any loss or damage.

Car Park

A reminder that the school car park is for the use of staff, out-of-school care, NLC taxis and the School Bus. Our Nursery children and staff walk through the car park to access the Nursery Garden. Disabled Parking Spaces are pre-arranged for the use of children with blue badges or school parking permits; further information is available via the School Office.

Attendance and Late-coming

Excellent attendance at school is important to allow your child to fulfil their potential and for them to have the best start and brighter future.

In line with NLC Policy, attendance and late-coming are being closely monitored as these have a marked effect on children's education. We will regularly issue communication to parents/carers when children's attendance falls below NLC's expected attendance figures. Please see the attached "Attendance Matters" leaflet for further information. We work closely with partner agencies, including our Cluster Family Engagement Support Assistant, to support attendance.

A reminder that, if your child arrives after 9am (and before 9.15am), they should enter via the Infant Gate and, if they arrive after 9.15am, they should enter via the Main Entrance (having entered the school grounds via pedestrian access paths and not the school car park).

P7 School Ties

We have been made aware of an issue with the length of this year's P7 school ties. I have spoken with our supplier, Scotcrest, and they have agreed to provide replacement ties at no cost. Any P7 who has purchased a new tie which measures 39 inches or shorter, will be able to exchange this for a new tie (42 inches in length) at the School Office. We will update P7 parents/carers when the new ties have been manufactured and delivered to the school.
