ATTENDANCE FACTS

Every pupil at our school must have an attendance of 96%. When a child's absence falls below this figure it has a dramatic impact on their learning. The figures below state very clearly the effect absence has on your child's learning.

WHEN ATTENDANCE DROPS TO 80% - OVER 5 YEARS A CHILD WILL LOSE A YEAR OF SCHOOLING
