Attendance

Regular attendance at school is important and is linked to improved achievements. I will be monitoring our monthly attendance statistics and will send a letter to parents when their child's attendance drops below 80%

I am aware that sometimes absence is unavoidable however, we want our children to do their best and regular attendance will support this.

Absence Policy

If your child has a medical/dental appointment during the school day please advise our office staff by handing in the appointment letter which they will copy for our records. It is vitally important that we are informed of all appointments during the course of the school day as this will ensure your child receives the correct absence mark.

Parents and carers are reminded to inform the school office before 9.30am if your child is unable to attend from the start of the school day on the first day of absence. Failure to do so will result in school staff sending a text to the main contact provided for the child. This is important for child safety and also ensures your child receives the correct absence mark.

Parents and carers are required to inform the school by letter or telephone if their child is likely to be absent for some time, and to give the child a note on his or her return to school confirming the reason for absence.

If you require to collect your child early from school then you must sign them out at the office.

Children whose attendance falls below 80% will be notified in writing by the school.

PE Reminder

An increasing number of pupils are coming to school without the proper PE kit. All pupils need to bring shorts, T-shirt and gym shoes so that they are able to fully participate in PE lessons.



All pupils will participate in two PE session per week.

If your child is unable to participate then please inform the class teacher in writing.
