<p>Rainbow Spelling Write each word in a different colour three times.</p> <p>said said said</p>	<p>Sentences Write a sentence for each word. Remember capital letters and full stops.</p>	<p>Dictionary Find the meaning for half of your words in a dictionary and write them into your jotter.</p>
<p>Typing Words Type your words into a word processor on your computer three times each. Make each one a different font. Print them off if you can or get someone to sign your jotter.</p>	<p>Pyramid Words Write each word out like a pyramid.</p> <p>s sa sai said</p>	<p>Circle the Vowels Write each word out three times and circle the vowels in a colour.</p> <p>Remember, vowels are a,e,i,o,u.</p>
<p>Mini Challenge Get someone at home to give you a mini spelling challenge. Get them to sign your homework jotter.</p>	<p>Write a paragraph Write a small paragraph about anything you like that can fit as many of your spelling words in as you can. Make sure it makes sense.</p>	<p>Circle the Consonants Write each word out three times and circle every consonant. Remember, consonants are the letters that aren't vowels.</p>
<p>Bubble Spelling Write each word out three times in bubble letters.</p>	<p>Words Within Words Write out each word and see if you can write two more words you can make from the letters in it, e.g. catch - cat, hat.</p>	<p>Other Hand Spelling Write out each word with the hand you don't usually write with.</p>
<p>Word Hunt Can you find your words in your reading book? Write down how many times you have found them.</p>	<p>Rhyming Words Can you find two words that rhyme with each spelling word?</p>	<p>Free Choice Can you think up your own spelling activity to do?</p>
