Can you write some sentences using your common words? Remember to add in connectives.



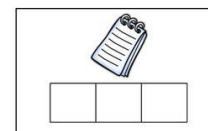
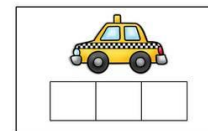
Can you write a set of instructions on how to do something? You can choose anything you like.
