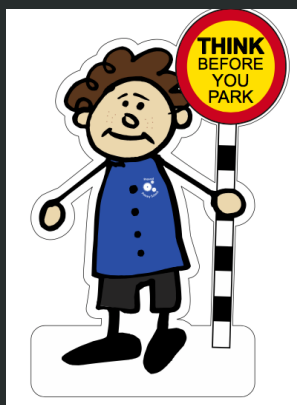

Christmas at Lawmuir



Unfortunately, this year our Christmas Celebrations will be slightly different to normal due to COVID-19 Guidelines. We have lots of fun things planned to still spread some Christmas Cheer!

This year we are planning 'Christmas at Lawmuir' a week of festive activities which are fun for our pupils but still keep us all safe.

Monday 14th December - A Christmas Story Afternoon

Class will share a festive story & complete some fun activities.

Tuesday 15th December - Christmas Movie Afternoon

Class share a Christmas Movie of their choice. Refreshments will be provided by the 'Friends of Lawmuir' Parent Council.

Wednesday 16th December - Christmas Craft Afternoon

Class will take part in a Christmas Craft Afternoon. These will be brought home to share with families.

Thursday 17th December Online Pantomime

Each class will watch the online pantomime in their class 'Robin Hood & his Socially Distanced Men'. This has been paid for by Friends of Lawmuir' Parent Council.

Friday 18th December Class Christmas Party

Each class holds a party in their classroom. Refreshments will be provided. (As this is not a traditional Christmas Party, party clothes are not required. This is also our Christmas Jumper day so pupils can dress down but shouldn't go home at lunch to change. Clothes should still be appropriate for being outside.)

We would respectfully ask you to avoid smoking at drop off/pick up times when waiting at the school gate. Please avoid this to allow all pupils & parents to be comfortable & safe.



We continue to ask Parents & Carers to remain out with the school building & grounds unless asked to attend by a member of staff. All visitors are required to complete Test & Protect paperwork as well as wearing a mask if asked to attend the school. We thank you for your co-operation with this matter.



Please do not send pupils to school with a lolly for snack or as part of their lunch. These can be dangerous in the playground in the event of a fall or bump and may cause injury. Thanks.

Christmas Jumper Day - Friday 18th December

This is our Christmas Jumper day so pupils can wear casual clothes and a Christmas Jumper. Suggested Donation £1

This will go towards school fund. Please as always no football colours. Clothes should be appropriate for season & possible outdoor learning no crop tops etc.

We have a small number of donated Christmas Jumpers available to pupils who do not have one. Please ask your child to speak to Miss Hurst should you like one sent home. If we have one to fit we will send this home discretely. (These have been washed and quarantined).

Christmas Cards

Could we please ask that Christmas Cards are not exchanged in school this year.

Christmas Lunch

Reminder that our Christmas Lunch will be on Wednesday 4th December. No other hot lunches or Snack-to-go are available. If you haven't already ordered your child should bring a packed lunch this day. Pupils can wear something festive along with their uniform if they would like. i.e. headband etc.

Colder Weather

Please be aware that over the coming winter months the windows in the classes may be open more frequently than they normally are at this time of year. This is to ensure that the school is well ventilated, helping minimize the risk of spread of infection. You may want to consider wearing an extra layer under uniform, making sure your child has a cardigan or jumper with them or sending in an additional fleece (Grey or Black where possible please).

All children should also ensure they have an outdoor jacket with them at all times. If sending hats, scarves or gloves please ensure they are labelled with your child's name.
