School Update

- Awaiting update from Scottish Government regards P1-3 Children. P4-7 pupils will continue to engage in online line learning until further guidelines released.

Digital Engagement

- Miss Law shared slides Pupil Survey Results on digital learning and the monitoring of Pupil Engagement for online learning for January.
- Feedback was very positive however another survey will go out again to pupils as only a 1/3 of pupils had completed survey. Mrs Walker raised the point that pupils who are not accessing digital learning did not have the opportunity to complete survey. Miss Law explained this will be considered for the next survey.
- Pupil Engagement slides showed how over the weeks this has been up and down. This is being closely monitored by Class Teachers and SMT. We are looking at different ways of motivating and encouraging pupils to do this.
Members asked how school would be doing this. Miss Law explained from the survey we have tweaked timetables reflective of the Pupil Survey results for each class. Class Teachers are telephoning parents/ pupils on a rotation basis to discuss how pupils are getting on.
Members raised the point that they had not received phone call. Miss Law explained rotation, parents could be called over the next few weeks.

Lateral Flow Tests

- Miss Law explained school has received tests and all school staff are being offered the home testing kit. Testing procedure is completed twice a week.

Fundraising and Events

- Members discussed Easter Fundraising event for pupils taking into consideration Covid- 19 guidelines, cost of the school day and donations from community.
