Parent Council Fun Day - Friday 16th June

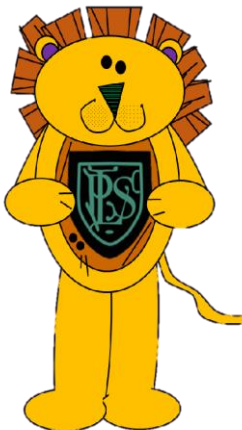
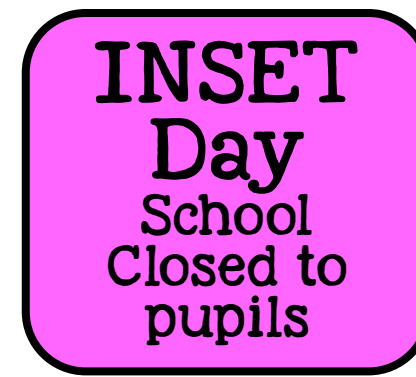
