## **Starting Back at Lawmuir PS**

As you will be aware, work on the Orbiston Community Hub has begun.

New fencing has been constructed to separate the school campus from the construction site.

The back gate will no longer be in use so all pupils will access/exit the school via the entrances on Footfield Road.

**Pupils in Primary 1 - 3 will use the gate at the infant playground.**

**Pupils in Primary 4 -7 will use the gate at the senior playground.**

All pupils attending the breakfast club will use the footpath and the main entrance.

As construction continues this will be subject to future alteration.

Morning Interval and Lunchtime will be split as we will have a reduced playground area.

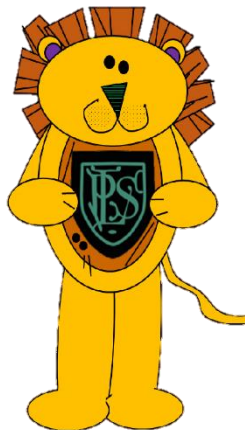
Pupils in Primary 1- 3 will have their interval from 10:30-10:45 and lunch from 12:00-12:45.

### Internet Acceptable Use Agreement – Separate Letter Issued

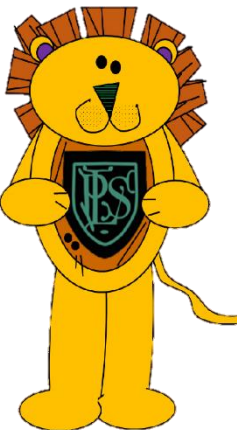
Please read over and discuss the acceptable use guidelines with your child before returning them to school by 1<sup>st</sup> September.
