

- Vegetarian Meal Option


All main courses will be served with a selection of seasonal vegetables and potatoes. Christmas Desserts will also be available.

Tickets are available (initially 2 per family) from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December. Tickets cost £2 per person.



### **Orbiston Community Hub Update**

We are delighted to confirm that all statutory approvals are now in place. The construction of Orbiston Community Hub will begin on site from the **4th December 2023**.

Our first activity will be to complete the fencing to create a boundary between the site, the schools and surrounding area.

The groundworks, including drainage and foundations, will begin followed by the erection of the steel frame in the spring.

Through liaison and agreement with the Roads Department, construction traffic to the site shall be from Hamilcomb Road through the existing entrance at the junction of Register Avenue. Access to the site will be controlled via the site gates. During construction, an additional temporary access will be formed off Babylon Road.

The project team are looking forward to building this new state of the art facility in your community. We will consider all our neighbours throughout the process and will keep you up to date with regular newsletters


