An operative is someone who works on a building site

IMPORTANT!

People working on construction sites are properly trained and wear protective clothing to stay safe.

Please stay safe by staying away from building sites!



Cyclist and pedestrian safety

Remember to always be careful when walking or cycling near construction sites, making sure to look both ways at site entrances for vehicles going in and out of sites.

Always make sure to stop, look and listen before crossing the road!



What have you learnt?

If you would like to know more about any building work in your area, you must make sure you ask a responsible adult to help you find out, instead of trying to find out yourself.
