REGISTRATION OF INFANT BEGINNERS IN PRIMARY SCHOOL SESSION 2024/25



Lawmuir Primary School

Children who attain the age of 5 years between 1 March 2024 and 29 February 2025 should be registered for education | during the week commencing **Monday 15 January 2024**.


If your child is due to begin primary school in August 2024, please phone the school to arrange an appointment for registration. Times will be allocated to avoid unnecessary congestion and long wait times. Throughout the week beginning **Monday 15th January**, appointments will be available between **10:30-12:00** and **14:00-15:00**.

Please note that birth certificates and a current council tax notice must be produced during registration.
