

## REGISTRATION OF INFANT BEGINNERS IN PRIMARY SCHOOL SESSION 2024/25



### Lawmuir Primary School

Children who attain the age of 5 years between 1 March 2024 and 29 February 2025 should be registered for education during the week commencing **Monday 15 January 2024**.
